▶▶ GETTING INTO THE ACTIVITY

A guessing game where being 'average' is best. Part of the 'House of Games' theme.

Download the 'Distinctly Average' activity sheet. This contains the 10 questions for this challenge. The rules for this activity are as follows:

- This game is played in pairs.
- Questions are asked which have a numerical answer.
- Without discussing, partners write down the answers independently and the average of the two numbers is the pair's answer.
- A point is awarded to the pair nearest the correct answer.
- The pair with the most points at the end of the game is the winner.

Example Question: How many grains of rice are in a 1kg bag?

- 8) How many minutes are there in a year? (without using a calculator!)
- 9) Which number on Pennsylvania Avenue is the formal address of the White House?
- 10) How much does the Prime Minister of the UK get paid? (Including MP salary)
