



GETTING INTO THE ACTIVITY

Hunt around looking for colourful doughnuts. Who will be the first to find the full set?

Preparation: Print out the 'Doughnut Hunt' Activity sheet. The first page has 16 doughnuts on it and the following two pages has these same 16 doughnuts on, but as larger images. Cut out the larger doughnuts and hide them around your meeting space. You'll need a complete set for each team you'll be playing with.

How to Play: Split into teams, with roughly 4 people in each team. Give each team the first page of the activity sheet, that shows all 16 doughnuts they need to find. On GO, one person from each team should hunt around the meeting space trying to find a doughnut. When they find one that they need, they should bring it back to the team and the next person in that team can go. Continue doing this until the team have found all 16 doughnuts. The quickest team is the winners.

Teams should be told beforehand that they can only collect one of each doughnut. If they already have a doughnut, they can't collect the same doughnut again (otherwise the other teams won't be able to find all of their doughnuts).

Virtual: Send out the doughnuts in activity packs or email to parents/carers and ask to print. Ask parent/carers to secretly hide the doughnuts before your session, so children can find them during the call.



WHAT YOU'LL NEED
