GETTING INTO THE ACTIVITY

Bring noughts and crosses to life in a game that requires accurate throwing skills as well as tactical play.

Set up a 3x3 grid using tape on the floor. 2-3 metres away create a throwing line. For this game you'll need someone to compete against, so grab a family member.

Each player needs some sock balls, ideally of different colours. One person could use black socks and the other person uses coloured socks. Take turns to throw a sock ball at the grid, trying to land it in the part of the grid you want to claim. The square where the sock ball stops in can be claimed by that person. Leave the sock ball in that square to show which square belongs to who. Once a square has been claimed, it can't be claimed by the other person if they land in it afterwards. The first person to get three in a row wins.

Variation: Stealing is now allowed. Each square belongs to the person that last landed in it. This means boxes can change, making the game much more tactical.



WHAT YOU'LL NEED

- Sock Balls
- Tape / Chalk
