## ▶▶ GETTING INTO THE ACTIVITY

We have far more in common with each other than we sometimes realise. Spend some time exploring the group's similarities.

Sometimes people like to focus on what makes us different. Examples might be liking different football teams or superheroes, coming from different countries or having different skin colours. Whilst we may all be made uniquely there are tonnes of things that we all have in common if we look hard enough. Use the below activity to help highlight this.

**Sticker Collectors:** A leader should have a sheet of stickers (stars, smiley faces etc). Call out some statements which lots of children should relate to (I go to school, I like sports, I have a brother/sister, I like pizza, I think BB is the best... and so on). After each statement children should collect a sticker if it relates to them. You could have a discussion after some statements to find out more (i.e favourite type of pizza, what sports they like etc) and learn more about our similarities. Keep going so each child has a top full of stickers.

At the end highlight that all their tops are now full of stickers - showing how much we all have in common. We should remember this next time we see someone lonely, being picked on, looking sad or needing a friend. Those people are just like us and if we have a chat or play with them, we will soon find out lots of things we have in common and ways we can make friends with them.
