# ICE CREAMS & LOLLIES

PART OF THE SUMMER THEMED PROGRAMME



## GETTING INTO THE ACTIVITY

On a hot summer's day there is nothing better than an ice cream or lolly to cool you down. However, in this puzzle our iced treats are all mixed up and need matching back together before they melt.

Print and cut up the 'Ice Creams & Lollies' activity sheet. Divide the group into small teams. You'll need a set for each team playing. The aim of the activity is to sort through the 12 cards and arrange them into matching pairs. To make the activity more interactive use an obstacle course or game for children to collect/win the cards before solving the puzzle.

**Obstacles:** Place the cards at the end of the obstacle course. Children should complete the course, collect a card and return it to their team.

**Game:** Play a competitive game such as races, penalties, dodgeball or a quiz. For every point / goal, award one of the puzzle cards.

**Melting Timer:** Add extra pressure by setting a timer for the puzzle to be completed in, otherwise the ice creams and lollies will 'melt'. Consider having an ice lolly for each child afterwards as a prize for completing the puzzle.

**Virtual:** Use the PowerPoint (kept in edit mode) via screenshare and allow children to tell you which cards match. Move the cards around on the screen until they are complete.
