GETTING INTO THE ACTIVITY

After the initial group stages, the Euros is a knockout competition, where teams play each other and only the winner makes it through to the next round. Create your own knockout tournament, debating and deciding who makes it to the next round and ultimately is crowned champion.

Take the concept of the Euros and a knockout competition and use it to find the champion for other important issues... Such as the group's favourite chocolate bar, biscuit or packet of crisps.

Download and print the 'It's a Knockout' activity sheet. This has the knockout table you'll be familiar with from the Euros. As a group decide which category you'd like to take on (or you could do multiple categories). There is also a blank version for you to create your own topic.

Working as one group, go through each 'match' and debate which chocolate bar / biscuit / crisp wins each time. Deciding between a Double Decker and a Galaxy is serious stuff, so make sure to take your time and take in everyone's views. Where there is disagreement have a discussion and then hold a vote.

Work through the knockout table, before holding the final round and crowning your champion.
