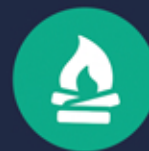
A trivia quiz like no other. We've set the questions, but you need to go and physically find the answers in your neighbourhood. Can you be creative enough to find the answers required?

THEME: EXPLORING THE WORLD AROUND ME



LEADER PREPARATION

A leader should consider if the local area around their meeting location is suitable for this activity. The area should be safe to walk around (i.e. no major roads or hazards) and have various places to explore (i.e. noticeboards, road signs, shops etc).

GETTING INTO THE ACTIVITY

- 1 Split the young people into smaller groups. Ideally 3-5 in a group.
- 2 Give each group a copy of the 'The Answer's Out There' question sheet. Each group will also need someone (young person or leader) with a camera phone.
- 3 Explain to the groups that they must try to answer the 20 quiz questions on their sheet, however written and verbal answers will not be accepted. Instead, they must take photos of items they find in their local community that answers the question. For example:

Q. In snooker, which ball is worth one point? **Potential answer:** Photo of a **red** traffic light

Q. Mark Zuckerberg founded which social media network? **Potential answer:** Photo of the **Facebook** logo from a poster in a shop window or noticeboard.

Q. The RAF aerobatic team are known as the Red _____? **Potential answer:** Photo of the **arrow** on a one-way sign.
- 4 The rules are as follows: All photos must be of objects and items found in their local area. Photos of other team members or of other team member's phones, with the answer on the screen, should not be accepted. Groups must stay together at all times. In the event of a draw, the group with the most creative photos win.
- 5 Before the groups leave, set them a time limit for when they should be back. The team with the most correct answers wins. Groups should be accompanied by a leader to ensure the activity is being carried out safely.



IDEAS TO TAKE THIS FURTHER...

After completing the activity, challenge the young people to write their own questions for a 'The Answer's Out There' style quiz for another age group (i.e. Juniors). Let the Company members run that activity with their chosen age group another week.



KEEPING EVERYONE SAFE

A risk assessment will need to be completed beforehand. The location used must be appropriate for young people to walk around safely. Please ensure suitable leader numbers and supervision for this activity. Care should be taken when crossing roads.
