



HEROES OF THE BIBLE PROJECT



AIM

The Bible is full of incredible people who lived courageous and inspiring lives. Take a closer look at some of the 'Heroes of the Bible' and what we can learn from them, before creating a group collage to finish the project.

WHAT YOU'LL NEED

- > Varies depending on characters and activities chosen.
- > Equipment to create a collage (i.e. lining paper, craft materials etc)

GET INTO THE BIBLE: HEROES OF THE BIBLE PROJECT

THEME: MY BIBLE ADVENTURE



LEADER PREPARATION

A leader will need to plan out the five sessions exploring the different Bible Heroes and find suitable activities for each session. We've provided some suggested resources to get you started.



GETTING INTO THE ACTIVITY

Weeks 1-5 – Heroes of the Bible (30 minutes per week): Spend some time over the course of five weeks looking at heroes of the Bible. Select a 'Bible Hero' for each week and focus on their story. What did they do and achieve? How did they use their faith to help them? What can we learn from their story? Try to use a mix of stories, discussions and games.

Week 6 – Heroes of the Bible Collage (30 minutes): Use the final session to look back at the five heroes of the Bible, whose stories you have explored, and then create a group collage that brings these stories together. The collage could include images/drawings/colouring of those heroes, key words about each character and what the group have learnt about them. Try to make a collage that could be displayed in your meeting space.

Suggested Heroes of the Bible

- Moses
- Noah
- David
- Esther
- Jonah
- Daniel
- Ruth
- Joseph

Resources to Support
