RANKING MY ADVENTURE

PART OF THE **SHAPING THE ADVENTURE** PROGRAMME



AIM

Challenge children to consider and express their feelings about their BB journey so far, whilst looking at how they shape the future of that adventure too. Feed back the results to BBHQ as part of our consultation with children and young people.

THEME: ESSENTIALS



LEADER PREPARATION

Print the Shaping the Adventure ranking cards. These will need to be cut into their individual cards before the activity.

GETTING INTO THE ACTIVITY

This activity forms part of our consultation with children and young people about their experiences and opinions of their time in The Boys' Brigade.

-  Print the Shaping the Adventure Ranking Cards and cut these into the individual cards. If working with a larger group, consider printing multiple copies so children can work in groups of 3 or 4.
- These ranking cards all describe experiences and opportunities most Anchors & Juniors should experience within their time in the BB. Talk the group through each of the cards, trying to give examples within your own programme of activities you do that match these cards.
- Now challenge children to put these cards into an order of which are the most important to them. The most important experiences/opportunities should go at the top of the list and the least important at the bottom. Explain that their final rankings will be sent to BBHQ who want to hear their opinions, to help ensure The Boys' Brigade is focused on things that are important to them.
- Allow children a few minutes to complete this activity, encouraging them to talk about their views and opinions as they go.
- If working in multiple groups let each group share their final rankings. Were there any similarities and differences between the groups?
- Thank the children for their contributions and explain that their results will be shared with BBHQ. Leaders may wish to keep a copy of the rankings, to help with your programme planning going forwards.
