PREPARATION NEEDED

AIM

October 2023 is the 140th anniversary of The Boys' Brigade. Celebrate this milestone by creating a time capsule to be opened in 10 years time at the 150th, when our Anchors have grown up to become Seniors. The Boys' Brigade was founded on 4th October 1883.

WHAT YOU'LL NEED

- > Plastic Container (Time Capsule Box)
- > A Padlock or Cable Ties
- 'A Letter to My Future Self' Template
- > Time Capsule Sign
- > Items to put inside the Capsule

LEADER PREPARATION



A leader will need to print out the template sheets (if using) and find a suitable container that can be made into the time capsule. Photos may also need to be collated and printed.

GETTING INTO THE ACTIVITY

- October 2023 is the 140th anniversary of The Boys' Brigade. In 10 years time it will therefore be the 150th anniversary, which will be a big celebration. Ask the group how old they will be in 10 years time? Most will be 15-18 and will therefore be in our Seniors age group!
- Create a time capsule that can be opened in 10 years time, when they are Seniors. It will be a great way of looking back at their time in Anchors and reflecting on their own BB history.
- Below are some ideas for things that can be placed inside the capsule. For a capsule you could use a plastic container or something similar. Make sure to place a lock or cable ties on the box and a sign to go on the outside so people don't open the capsule early.
 - Group Photo: Take a group photo to put in the capsule. This will be a nice thing to look back on in 10 years time to see how everyone has grown up.
 - Photos of Activities: Print some photos of activities you have done recently. How will the activities your Anchors do now be different to those they do when they are Seniors?
 - A Letter to My Future Self: Use our template to allow Anchors to write a letter to their future self. This can capture their likes and dislikes today as well as some of their hopes for the future. We've provided a written letter template as well as one that uses drawings.
 - · Artwork / Craft: Could you add a couple of pieces of artwork or some recent crafts you have done in Anchors? This will show the creative activities they did when they were in Anchors.
 - BB Badges / Certificates etc: Place some BB badges, recent certificates or medals etc into the time capsule too. In 10 years, those opening the capsule will be able to see the achievements of the group - some of which they may have forgotten about in the future.
 - Other Ideas: Is there anything else they would like to add to the time capsule? Maybe a newspaper or mementos from 2023 (i.e. photos of them celebrating the Coronation).
