### SETTING INTO THE ACTIVITY



Start by asking what the group's favourite ever Christmas present has been? Can they remember their favourite one?

Now ask the group, if they could ask for anything this Christmas, regardless of cost etc, what would they want for Christmas? What would be the 'perfect' Christmas present?

Christmas can be a great season, as there are so many brilliant things that happen around Christmas. Incredible food, lots of time with family and friends, parties and special activities, visits from Father Christmas and of course... great presents!

Christmas presents such as top of the range gadgets, the latest PlayStation games and the current fashion trends all come and go. This year's top Christmas present won't be relevant or desired next year, in the same way that no one is asking this year for the most popular presents from 2022. That's just the way things are and the world we live in. We are forever after the next best thing and the most up to date offering.

5 2,000+ years ago, on that very first Christmas, there wasn't an Xbox, PlayStation or iPhone in sight. However despite this lack of 'incredible presents', something happened that changed the world forever and has remained relevant ever since – despite our forever need for 'newer and better'.

This gift wasn't bought in a shop or online and was never neatly wrapped in colourful wrapping paper. Yet the baby Jesus was by far the best gift we've ever been given. This is because it was God's way of showing us all just how much he loves us. By giving us Jesus, it means that all of us can be closer to God forever.
